Support clinical decision making at point of care through electronic tools (7 activities) <p><i>Each IT Domain Measure Activity is worth 5%, with maximum total credit possible of 20%. To receive the full 20% credit, a minimum of four (4) activities, at least two (2) of which come from Measure 2, are required.</i></p>
<i>Recommended Payment Weighting</i>	20%

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BONUS OPPORTUNITY	1. Physician Incentive Bonus: POs can receive up to an additional 10% for a physician-level incentive program incorporating regular measurement and feedback on clinical metrics and/or patient experience to individual physicians.

Colorectal Screening – Collect sample size information through 2005 CAS survey and explore administrative specifications 3. Nephropathy Monitoring for diabetics – Use HEDIS Administrative specifications
DEVELOPMENT MEASURES <i>MEASURES FOR WHICH SPECIFICATIONS WILL BE DEVELOPED FOR FUTURE TESTING</i>	1. Antidepressant Medication Mgmt. – alternative to HEDIS 2. Obesity – questions on CAS Survey 3. Diabetic Retinal Exam – modified from HEDIS Administrative specification
