Exclusion: Any PCP who either sees no patients 2 years or older, or who believes that all three vital signs of height, weight, and blood pressure of their patients have no relevance to their scope of practice.

Scoring: Scoring is determined by the percent of the organization's PCPs or PCPs serving a percentage of the organization's commercial HMO/POS members, who are able to meet the intent of the measure.
