

## MEDI-CAL P4P CORE MEASURE SET

Based on the feedback from the Advisory Committee meeting, additional input from the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), and keeping in line with the recommended approach to focus on measures for which plans and providers are already held accountable, the core measure set for Medi-Cal P4P programs is outlined below. All measures included in the core measure set are External Accountability Set measures and five are also Auto-Assignment measures.
